

**GRAY WATER DISTRICT  
TRUSTEES' MEETING  
July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

Present: Bruce Sawyer, Steve Dunn, Joe Murray, Andrew Edson and Superintendent Jim Foster.  
Bruce called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

**Superintendents Report:**

- a. VOC results were below detection limits (BDL)
- b. June bacteria tests were absent for E-coli and total coliform.
- c. AGM: 268
- d. Have not yet decided what to do to honor Robert Skillings service to the District. Bruce suggested a flag pole dedicated in his name. Trustees discussed briefly and everyone seemed to like the idea.
- e. Sidewalk Project: They have paved. If we would like to change over services we will have to dig up pavement but may have time to get the work done before the sidewalk is completed and so avoid digging that up. Trustees decided not to dig new pavement up.
- f. Route 26 paving is ongoing.
- g. Exit 63 project: nothing new to report, more paving coming soon.
- h. Safety program is coming together. We will be doing training on Thursday July 20<sup>th</sup>.
- i. A significant water leak on Weymouth road has been repaired.

**Trustee Reports:**

Steve reported that he recently spoke to Town Councilor Jason Wilson. Jason mentioned that he is encouraging the Town to have better communication with Gray Water District.

Steve reported that he has received VOC the test results from 2015 Water Quality Monitoring Gray Municipal landfill that was spoken about at the last meeting. All results were BDL. The final VOC tests at these locations will take place in 2018.

August meeting was scheduled for August 21, 2017.

**Joe made a motion to adjourn at 7:43 pm. Steve seconded, vote was unanimous.**
