TRUSTEES' MEETING

Present: Bruce Sawyer, Joe Murray, Mike Lessard, Andrew Edson and Superintendent Jim Foster. Bruce called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Superintendents Report:

- a. AGM: 261
- b. September & October bacteria tests were absent for E-coli and total coliform.
- c. We have not received any additional odor complaints since addressing those reported last month.
- d. We have delivered a disconnect notice to the customer on Libby Hill with the leak on private property. Skillings said last week that they will be over there the first of the week so that would be today or tomorrow.
- e. Salt study: sampling will be done on wells that were purposed according to Bruce Fowler.
- f. We have not heard back from Doug Webster on Town TIF's from last month. Steve did make a list of items the District would like to achieve in the future for the Town. Trustees discussed briefly and added a couple more things.

Trustee Reports:

Mike spoke to a geologist that mentioned the fish hatchery as a potential water source. After discussion Mike wasn't sure if it was the one in New Gloucester or not. He will check on that and report back next month.

Acquisition of Property:

Joe made a motion to go into executive session pursuant to M.R.S.A. Section § 405(6)(C) to consider the acquisition of Real Property at 7:28. Mike seconded, vote was unanimous.
